Public Transport

if you're getting a train or bus, double check the service before you leave for the station - British weather is notorious for impacting public transport, sometimes causing delays or cancelled services.

keep your mobile phone charged and updated with useful contacts in case you miss the last train or bus home - a taxi company or a reliable friend who won't mind popping out to collect you

Driving

double check your car insurance; do you have roadside cover and pick-up if you break down?
